Under the aegis of Gondia Education Society, Gondia, Seth NarsinghdasMor College, Tumsar was established in the year 1965. In the course of time, to cater to the needs of the surrounding area, the science wing was attached to the erstwhile humble venture and the college became Seth NarsingdasMor College of Arts& Commerce & Smt G. D. Saraf Science College, Tumsar. In a short span of time, a few more branches – English Literature, Post Graduation and Computer Science were added to it. As a part of fulfilling the need and demands of the students' fraternity, an extra B. Sc. section was started, which is presently on No-Grant-Aided basis. This section has been getting an overwhelming response, and is being run successfully. The college has a study centre of YashwantraoChavhan Open University as well. The College offers education at Jr. College level in Arts and Science, which run with its full capacity.

The college which had a humble beginning in two small rented rooms in the year 1965 in the neighbouring school, has now grown into enormous shape with its own huge building comprising spacious classrooms, modern laboratories, well-furnished library with 50000 plus valuable books in its stacks, sport complex and play ground with modern equipment, computer lab, automated office, well qualified faculty, independent toilets for boys and girls, comfortable staff rooms, canteen, clean and pure drinking water, etc., imparting education to more than 1000 students. The alumni of the college are enjoying foremost positions in India and abroad. I would like to inform this august gathering that the Former M. P. And former MLA are the alumni, the products of this college. In 2015-16 the college celebrated its Golden Jubilee. The college was accredited 'B' by NAAC Peer team.

In the current academic year, keeping in with the tradition, in order to streamline the various activities, each faculty has formed its association.

The Science Faculty members have earned international recognition. Dr. M. F. Jadhao presented a research paper in an International Conference in Dubai, the UAE. A research scholar has been awarded Ph. D. degree under his supervision this year and He also published a paper in UGC CARE listed journal. Wild Life Week was organized by the department.

Dr. Jagannath Vishwanath Gadpayale, Assistant professor, Department of Botany. Reported a New Ficus johannis for the first time for Indian flora. This report is recognised by Ministry of Environment and Sciences along with Botanical Survey of India in Plant Discoveries - 2021-22. He also reported two New plants for the Maharashtra state Flora. He also wrote a book for the Sem III students.

Dr Pravin A. Dhakite from the department of Chemistry has earned a Patent entitled GREEN BIO-POLYMER AND METHOD OF PREPARATION THEREOF to his credit by the Government of India.

Dr. V. V. Warhste has been elected as a member on Board of Studies Physics.

Students of Botany Department carry out surveys under the guidance of HoD Dr. Sathawane and Prof Khobragade.

In Arts stream, the college's Department of Sociology, headed by Dr. R. J. Bhagat has been regularly publishing half yearly journal- *Social Issues and Problems* since June 2012. This Journal has citation index. Dr. Bhagat has been conferred with the Best Professor and Researcher by Marathi Samajshastra Parishad. He has been also elected as the President of Marathi Samajshastra Parishad.

English is a key to success. Department of English, with the initiative of Prof.Khandwehas instituted the *Forum for Efficiency in English Language and Literature (FEELL)*. Under its aegis, the department conducts exams for improving English. This year, a test on 'English language Proficiency' was organised.. Dr. R. K. Dipte, HoD, English , presented a paper in the International Conference in Dubai, the UAE. Dr. R. K. Dipte is entrusted with the work as a paper setter for MPSC exam. He is also IQAC Coordinator. The faculty is involved in the Research activities. Under the guidance of Head of the Department, Dr. R. K. Dipte, 7 research students have earned Ph. D. degree and 13 students have got M. Phil. Degree so far. Prof.Khandwe presented a research papers in the International Conference at Goa.

From the Department of Marathi, a well known literary critic from the college, Dr R. K. Ubale has been awarded Ph. D. degree by Swami Ramanand Tirth Marathwada University, Nanded, recently. Thus as many as 14 professors are Ph. D. degree holders. The remaining are working on Ph. D. research work as well. Dr. Rajesh Dipte from the department of Marathi has been nominated as a member of Board of Studies in Marathi.

Prof. Sachin Welurkar from the department of Political Science provides training to students on competitive exam under the career Guidance and Placement cell. Under this, competitive examination book exhibition, guidance workshops, expert guidance etc. were organized. Dr. Werulkar was nominated as a member on the Political Science Board of study Nagpur University.

Dr. J. M. Maskey HoD, Economics has been nominated as a member of Special Task Force of RTMNU in the subject of Economics. He has been recognized by RTMNU for guiding and supervising Ph.D. scholars. He was conferred with Best Researcher Award by Research Education Solution, Delhi..
