Report

Economics Survey Undertaken by the Department of Economics

The students of **B. A. first** year from Department of Economics undertook a survey as a part of their academic study on **May 4, 2023**. The students visited nearby village **Hasara** to survey and collect information regarding the course. As many as **twenty Seven students** participated in the survey to collected information. **Fifty Households** were surveyed .The questions asked were regarding to their Annual Income, Monthly Expenditure, and Savings; Land Holdings, Supporting Business many also.

It is found that as many as **45 households** are living under low income and do not have other source of income. Due to their low income they do not have enough money to spend to meet their daily needs. So it is found that as many as **45 households** do not meet their daily needs.

When it asked regarding saving most of them don't have money to save. As many as **44 families** replied they don't have any savings.

When inquired about their allied activities (supporting business) like Goat Farming, Poultry Farming, and Dairy Farming most of them replied that they don't have any allied activity. And some have income source from Dairy farming.

When asked about land holding 18 Families replied that they have their own land. The percentage of land holders to total surveyed is about to 36. It reflects the landlessness among

the villagers.

The staff from the department also visited the village with the students that work as moral

supports to them. The activity gives good experience to the students on how to survey and

collect information.
