

## **GEOGRAPHICAL STUDY TOUR**

### **(CHANDPUR)**

**7/03/2025**

The students of Geography Department were taken to “Chandpur” for the Educational tour on 7/03/2025. 22 students from 4<sup>th</sup> semester and 2 Lecturers were participated in this study tour.

Chandpur is a small village situated at the foot of a hill. As there is a temple of Lord Hanuman in this village, there is a Yatra every Saturday and the local businesses have been boosted. Chandpur is famous in Tumsar taluka as a tourist destination. The nearby villages of Chandpur benefit from the water from the canal when the agriculture nearby is wet.

Chandpur, located in the Tumsar taluka of Bhandara district in Maharashtra, is known for its Chandpur Dam, a reservoir created by a dam on the Chandpur river, and the surrounding hilly terrain and dense forests. The dam's height above the lowest foundation is 19 meters (62 feet), and its length is 1,051 meters (3,448 feet). The dam has a volume content of 80.36 cubic kilometers (19.28 cubic miles) and a gross storage capacity of 29,025.00 cubic kilometers (6,963.47 cubic miles). A large reservoir has been created by constructing a wall between two hillocks. The reservoir is surrounded by hillocks with dense plantations. The fort has a Dargah of Sufi saints and some other tombs. Chandpur fort is at a distance of 52 km from Bhandara city and at a distance of 21 km from Tumsar taluka. This square-shaped fort is spread over an area of 1 acre and this fort built on the slope of the hill has four collapsed bastions at the four ends in its rampart. Students observe all these Geographical aspects and enjoyed the natural beauty.
