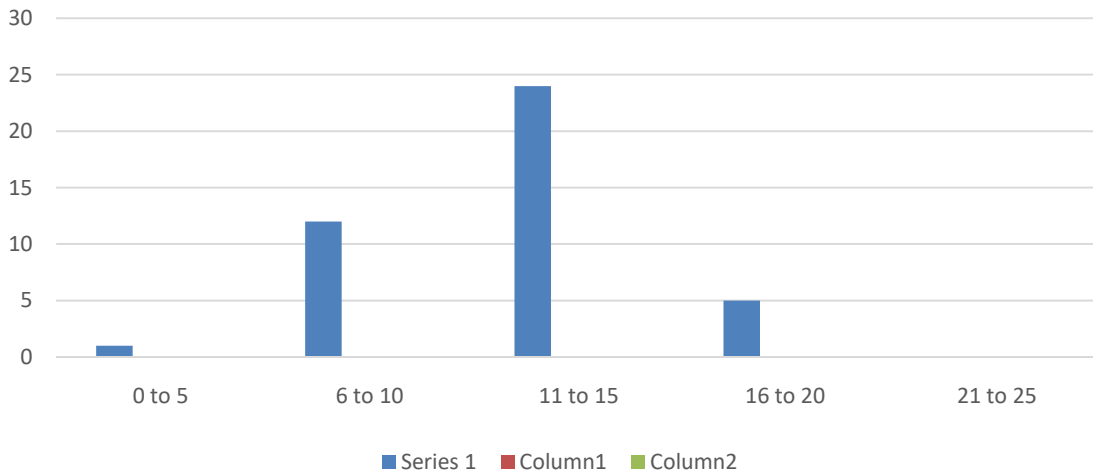

Findings: After evaluation of the responses, five ranges of the secured marks were made as students securing within the range 0 to 5 marks, 6 to 10 marks, 11 to 15 marks, 16 to 20 marks and 21 to 25 marks. It was found as - 01 student secured marks within 0 to 5, 12 students secured marks within 6 to 10, 24 students secured marks within 11 to 15, 05 students secured marks within 16 to 20, and 00 student secured marks within 21 to 25.

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Conclusion: The school is residential Ashram School. It means that students are in academic ambience for 24 hours every day. Majority of students secured marks in the middle range, that is, 11 to 15 = 13 out of 42 = $13/42 \times 100 = 30.9\%$. The students are from villages and are mainly tribal- Definitely, their knowledge of English is satisfactory. No student attained marks above 21, which means above 80%. The fact is really deplorable and much needs to be done.
