A questionnaire of 25 questions on general basic English grammar was prepared. The respondents had to select correct option from two given choices as the response. Questionnaire and response are with the department.



**Findings**: After evaluation of the responses, five ranges of the secured marks were made as students within the range 0 to 5 marks, 6 to 10 marks, 11 to 15 marks, 16 to 20 marks and 21 to 25 marks. It was found as 01 student secured marks within 0 to 5, 06 student secured marks within 6 to 10, 19 students secured marks within 11 to 15, 16 students secured marks within 16 to 20, and 00 student secured marks within 21 to 25. The understanding of the basic s of the English language is a little bit higher than the students studying in the Arts stream in the same school.



**Conclusion**: The school is residential Ashram School. It means that students are in academic ambience for 24 hours every day. Majority of students secured marks in the middle range, that is, 11 to 15 = 19 out of 42 = 19/42\*100 = 45%. The students are from villages and are mainly tribal- Definitely, their knowledge of English is satisfactory. No student



attained marks above 21, which means above 80%. The fact is really deplorable and much needs to be done.
